What is Help DiaBEATes?

It's a campaign, supported by the NHS, to encourage people with diabetes to get involved in research. Better care and treatments are only possible through research. Together we could Help BEAT Diabetes.

What does it involve?

Joining Help DiaBEATes is free. When you sign up, we will ask you for your contact details, type of diabetes and year of diagnosis.

We will explain the different types of research available and you can tell us which of these you are interested in.

It is always your decision whether you take part in any research we tell you about. Your participation is completely voluntary and you can withdraw from a study or from Help DiaBEATes at any time without it affecting your diabetes care.

We take data protection very seriously. All our records are kept in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. Your information is stored on our secure NHS database and access to it is strictly limited.
